

## Humber in good Health

- 14.9% of employment in the Humber is in **Health & Social Care**
- **Apprenticeships** are offered by nearly all Health & Social Care organisations
- 84% of Adult Health & Social Care workers in the Humber are female, **more males** are needed!
- Jobs in the sector are extremely varied and include: Hospital Porters, Social Workers, Radiographers, Speech and Language Therapy Assistants, Surgeons...and many more!

## Food for thought?

- We know that the Leeds City Region is the UK's main financial and business services centre outside London, but did you know about the thriving food and drink sector...

- In 2014, there were **17,600 people employed** by food and drink manufacturing companies in West Yorkshire
- Shift work is common in the industry, with many production lines **open 24 hours** a day
- Between 2010 and 2020, there are predicted to be **38,000 vacancies** in the Leeds City region, for process, plant and machine operatives because of retirements, illness and job changers
- Major **food and drink manufacturers and processors** include Arla Foods, Coca Cola, Haribo, Nestle, Pepsico, Seabrooks, Symington's and Timothy Taylor. There are also many successful smaller producers


## All about the money...

- Sheffield City Region is a growing location in the UK for **business, professional and financial services** companies
- The sector has an output of almost £2.5 billion and **employs 73,000 people** in the region
- **Contact centre** employment is estimated at over 30,000 people. **Business outsourcing** companies employ around 15,000 and this looks likely to increase
- Financial services providers in the area include **HSBC's** global IT shared service centre, the largest private sector employer in the region (it employs over 4500 people!)

## Full of Energy!

The energy industry is big in North Yorkshire:

- **Drax**, in Selby is the UK's largest power station
- The world's biggest offshore windfarm is planned for off the Yorkshire coast at **Dogger Bank**. It will cover 430 sq miles and is expected to generate enough electricity to power nearly 2m homes, creating 900 jobs
- **White Moor power station**, Selby is powered by used cooking oil powering 18,000 homes
- **The Allerton Waste Recover Plant**, Northallerton will create 400 building jobs and another 70 operations jobs. It is expected to process 320,000 tonnes of household and other waste, and generate electricity to power 40,000 homes
